## REGISTRATION & ACCEPTANCE FEES

---

A non-refundable Registration Fee per pupil is payable when an application is made for a place at The Mount School. Additionally, when a place is offered to a pupil, there is an Acceptance Contract to be completed by parents and returned with a non-refundable Acceptance Fee. The Acceptance Fee will not be refunded if a place is not taken up.

## BOARDING REGISTRATION FEE & DEPOSIT

---

For boarding pupils, a non-refundable Registration Fee per pupil is payable when an application is made for a place at The Mount School. Additionally, when a place is offered there is an Acceptance Contract to be completed by parents and returned with a requirement to pay a refundable deposit which includes the Acceptance Fee. The boarding deposit will be refunded, less the Acceptance Fee and any outstanding balance after a pupil leaves the School. The boarding deposit will not be refunded if the place is not taken up and a term's notice has not been given.

## PAYMENT OF FEES

---

Invoices will be issued termly and are due for payment no later than the first day of the term to which they relate. Invoices will include additional charges that have been incurred during previous terms. In the event of non-payment of fees, interest will be charged at 2.5% per annum above the Base Rate of the School's Bank (HSBC). The pupil is at risk of being excluded from the School until such outstanding fees have been paid in full.

## PAYMENT OF FEES IN ADVANCE

---

The Mount School offers a Fees in Advance Scheme which provides parents with a financial benefit by paying a lump sum in advance. Savings against full fees are calculated using an assumed rate of return on the lump sum which is then accrued in the fund. (The risk of not achieving the rate is borne by the School). The savings offered under the scheme are often considered more attractive by parents than other investments where the interest is a taxable benefit.

## DISCOUNTS

---

Discounts of 5% are available for pupils who are members of a Quaker meeting, or whose parents are current members of the UK Armed Forces.

Siblings of a current pupil will receive a 5% discount, for as long as the older sister remains in the School.

Discounts of 10% are available for pupils whose parents are former pupils.

## BURSARIES

The Mount School has a long history of providing financial assistance to pupils and their families through Bursaries. Bursaries are intended to provide financial support for families so that their children may benefit from a Mount School education. A bursary is means-tested, so the value of the bursary is relative to the financial resources of the pupil's family. A bursary is expressed as a percentage of the standard day fee and will reduce the termly bills proportionately.
