Adele is a York based Digital Photomontage Artist. Her love of antiquities and oddities, old doors and weathered surfaces are the foundations of her work. Her ever growing collection of 19th century photographs is where she chooses her character and brings them back to full colour, intertwining them with creatures big and small, coupled with delicate foliage, she creates images both sophisticated and playful.

Her images are created using her digital camera, flat bed scanner and Photoshop. Bringing all the images together digitally, drawing on her experience with layering and affecting, she then prints the image on to Museum Heritage archival paper and continues to hand finish with inks, paint and sometimes gold leaf.

Ben has exhibited in Britain, Europe and America, his work is represented in public collections in Britain and Germany, and he is a fellow of the Craft Potters Association.

From the beginning of his career as a potter, Ben's pieces were always shallow, with trompe l'oeil illusions. For the first fifteen years his work was high fired stoneware in an oil reduction kiln, now he fires to an oxidised stoneware in an electric kiln to achieve cleaner, brighter colours.

"I work in my studio in York and focus mainly on Linocuts although I do like to try out lots of printmaking techniques and also make collages from pieces of my prints. York and the Yorkshire countryside are sources of inspiration for my work as is my allotment and the wildlife that I see there.

I have been printmaking for about twenty years and taught myself to relief-print using just a few tools, lino, paper and ink. Then I completed a degree in Fine Art at Leeds College of Art. It was here that I was introduced to printmaking using all of the facilities that a print studio had to offer. Following this, I attended a Linocut workshop where I was introduced to the locally produced Hawthorn etching presses. I took the plunge, invested in a press and this was the real start of my printmaking journey."

The inspiration for my work mainly comes from the places I visit. I take photographs of anything that catches my eye as I like to capture a moment instantly.






